Counseling Component

- Maintain all Puente selected students on his/her counselor caseload
- Ensuring 9th and 10th grade cohorts remain intact

Student Recruitment & Selection

- Adherence to the Student Selection Guidelines.
- Outreach to feeder middle school(s) to present the Puente Program and encourage the application process.
- With collaboration with the Puente teacher(s), the counselor selects a mixed ability class with equal distribution among the Puente student categories.

Community Leadership Component

Counselor supports the teacher in engaging students in highlighting aspects of community engagement and leadership.
