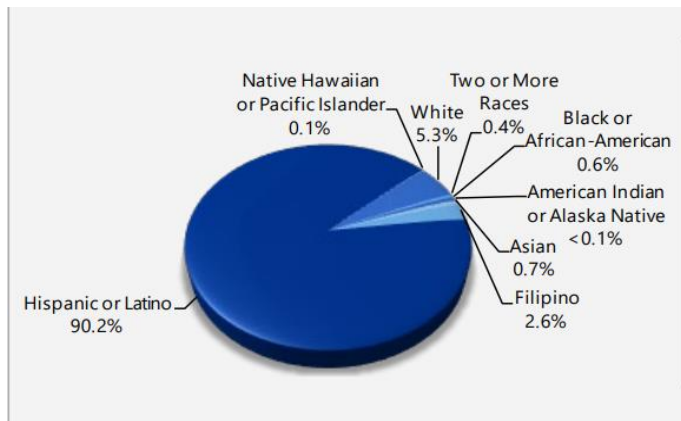

COMMUNITY: Everett Alvarez High School is one of six public high schools in the Salinas Union High School District. Everett Alvarez is located in Salinas, Ca. a rural setting with much agricultural business.

SCHOOL: Everett Alvarez High School, established in 1997 is a comprehensive four-year public high school and is accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges. Everett Alvarez has a current enrollment of approximately **2,247 students**. Our approximate counselor to student ratio for 2020-2021 is 1:430. The school operates on a block schedule divided into two (2) eighteen (18) week semesters with two (2) reporting periods each semester.** We also offer two California Partnership Academies: Agriculture Business and Digital Media Arts that include a career focus and support for students to meet the A-G Requirements. We have four strong programs on campus to help first-generation students successfully attain a four-year college education: [AVID](#), [PUENTE](#) (Univ. of California sponsored academic program), Migrant Education, and [Upward Bound](#). Additionally, we are fortunate to have a strong Navy Junior Reserve Officers Training Corps. (NJROTC) to help students become more disciplined and focused on their future.
